

ELSA HOLGUÌNPresident and CEO of Denver Preschool Program

Elsa Holguín grew up in a small town in Chihuahua, Mexico and immigrated to the United States with her family when she was 17. Elsa learned English while attending high school and college in Denver, where she worked as an intern in the nonprofit sector. That internship eventually led her to the

Women's Foundation of Colorado, and then to Rose Community Foundation where she served as the senior program officer for Child & Family Development for 21 years.

Elsa played an instrumental role in the creation of Early Milestones Colorado, the Latino Community Foundation of Colorado, the Denver Opportunity Youth Initiative, Colorado's Office of Early Childhood, Borealis Philanthropy, and the Skills to Compete Coalition. A former member and co-chair of the Early Childhood Leadership Commission, Elsa currently serves on the board of Tools of the Mind and the Preschool Policy Leadership Committee.

Elsa is the President and CEO of the Denver Preschool Program, an organization that makes quality possible for all Denver families with preschool children through dedicated sales tax approved by the voters in 2006 and renewed and expanded in 2014. DPP has provided nearly \$138 million in tuition support to help more than 60,000 Denver children attend the preschool of their family's choice, establishing each child's foundation for lifelong learning and success.

OUR MISSION

At Colorado Youth for a Change, we believe all students can overcome seemingly insurmountable obstacles to learn, to succeed in school, and to graduate. Founded in 2005 in response to over 18,000 youth dropping out of Colorado schools each year, our work spans from PreK all the way through age 21.

We support students at critical junctures by building early literacy by third grade; supporting math proficiency by eight grade; boosting engagement and attendance in high school; and helping youth get back into school after dropping out. Along with 30 school districts and the thousands of students we partner with each year, we thank you for fueling the potential in Colorado students through education.

Here is what your support helped make possible during the 2020-2021 school year:

COLORADO PRE-K READING CORPS: helping students enter kindergarten ready to learn

- 147 students served in one-on-one and classroom settings
- 2,874 tutoring hours were provided with 93 percent program fidelity

COLORADO READING CORPS: helping students become strong readers by end of third grade

- 877 students who were reading below grade level were served
- 79.2 percent achieved more than a full year of academic growth in reading

CORPS FOR A CHANGE: increasing school engagement

- 425 students were served with nearly 5,000 one-on-one attendance support sessions and family engagement sessions
- 75 percent of students improved in at least two asset categories on the Development Assets Post Assessment


REENGAGEMENT PROGRAM: reenrolling students who left school without graduating

- 131 students were enrolled back into school
- 80 percent of students either graduated or continued in school

COMING THIS YEAR: Math Corps

Launching in the 2021-22 school year, Math Corps will help 4th-8th grade students build math skills that are critical for long-term success in math. Math Corps adopts a sequential and mastery-oriented approach in which students progress through math concepts at their own speed. Research is clear that attaining algebra readiness by eighth grade is a key indicator of a student's future success. Only 35% of eighth grade students are proficient in math and as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, math scores nationwide in 3rd-8th grade students have dropped by 5-10% in the last year. Following such an unprecedented year, Colorado Math Corps will act as a necessary support system for students who have lost nearly a year of in-person education as well as the Colorado public school system.

This past year, CYC partnered with Serve Colorado and the Governor's Office to recruit additional AmeriCorps members through the Student Engagement Corps. Members supported nearly 2,600 students during the 2020-2021 school year, from kindergarten through 12th grade. Roles included attendance support, academic tutoring, supporting social and emotional growth with students, and helping students and families navigate remote learning platforms and communication. Members helped to ensure district communication was translated for families where English may be a second language and created special instructions and supports for entire families.


