7:30 AM - 8:30 AM

Arrive at school site, check emails, greet students, and prepare materials for morning intervention groups

8:30 AM - 12:00 PM

Meet with students in small groups to practice Math Corps interventions and/or Fact Fluency

12:00 PM - 12:30 PM

Lunch break
Eat in staff lounge to build community or take time for self

12:30 PM - 12:45 PM

Prepare materials for afternoon intervention groups

12:45 PM - 2:30 PM

Meet with students in small groups to practice Math Corps interventions and/or Fact Fluency

2:30 PM - 3:10 PM

Record student progress and tutoring minutes from the day in Math Corps data system

3:10 PM - 3:30 PM

Assist with student dismissal

3:30 PM - 4:00 PM

Finish data entry, check email, check in with coach and teachers about student progress, prep for tomorrow

APPLY TODAY FOR MATH CORPS

Three start dates in August, October and January
Full-time commitment (35-40 hours/week)
Program runs through May 31st, 2024.

Must have qualifications:

- 17 years or older by start date
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Submit to a background check if hired

Benefits:

- Free and immediate health insurance
- \$1,257 (pretax) stipend paid out 2x/month
- \$4,826.50 education award
- Bus pass/mileage reimbursement
- Professional development
- School breaks and holidays off
- Access to mental health services

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
