



## DAY IN THE LIFE OF AN EARLY LEARNING TUTOR

### • 7:30 AM - 8:00 AM

Arrive at school site, check in with teacher, check emails, and prepare materials for the day

#### 8:00 AM - 9:30 AM

Greet students, engage with students during breakfast, support students during morning large group instruction

#### 9:30 AM - 11:15 AM

Lead small group interventions with students, then engages with students at playground time and helps transition them back inside for lunch

#### 11:15 AM - 11:45 AM

Lunch break

#### 11:45 AM - 12:45 PM

Engage students during Choice Time by leading an interactive read-aloud in the classroom library

#### 12:45 - 1:45 PM

Student nap time Complete data entry, check email, and prep take home materials for students

#### 1:45 PM - 2:30 PM

Support students to transition to outdoor time before leaving for the day, sing math or literacy song as students line up

#### 2:30 PM - 4:00 PM

Student dismissal ends, help teacher clean up, prepare materials for the next day's small groups and read-aloud

# EARLY LEARNING CORPS

Three start dates in August, October and January Full-time commitment (35-40 hours/week)
Program runs through May 30th, 2025.

#### Must have qualifications:

- 17 years or older by start date
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permeant resident
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Submit to a background check if hired

#### Benefits:

- Free and immediate health insurance
- \$1,247 (pretax) stipend paid out 2x/month
- \$5,176, \$3,687 or \$2,817 education award
- Bus pass/mileage reimbursement
- Professional development
- School breaks and holidays off
- Access to mental health services

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
