7:30 AM

Arrive at school

Greet and welcome students into the building and check in with school site supervisor.

8:00 AM

Planning time

Check emails and caseload students' attendance from yesterday. Complete data entry and check in with CYC Program Coordinator.

8:45 AM

Meet with caseload students

Meet with students individually to discuss attendance, grades, mental health and social-emotional skills.



12:00 PM

Lunch Break

Eat in staff lounge to build community or take time for self.

12:30 PM

Staff meetings

Attend weekly collaborative meetings with other school staff.

1:00 PM

Meet with caseload students

Meet with students individually to discuss attendance, grades, mental health and social-emotional skills.



2:30 PM

Classroom support

Provide additional support to caseload students in their classrooms or wellness spaces.

3:00 PM

CCA Coursework

Complete assignments for Behavioral Health Credential.

3:30-4:00 PM

Finish out the day

Provide broader school wide engagement support through tutoring, attendance phone calls and supporting extra curriculars.
