



# Day in the life of a **MATH CORPS TUTOR**

Math Corps tutors support students in grades K–3 or 4–8 through weekly 90-minute tutoring sessions meeting in pairs or small groups. While school schedules vary, here's what a typical day could look like!



**7:30 AM**

### Arrive at school

Check emails, greet students, and prepare materials for morning intervention groups.

**8:30 AM**

### Math tutoring

Meet with students in small groups to practice Math Corps interventions and/or Fact Fluency.

**12:00 PM**

### Lunch break

Eat in staff lounge to build community or take time for self.



**12:30 PM**

### Planning time

Prepare materials for afternoon intervention groups.

**12:45 PM**

### Math tutoring

Meet with students in small groups to practice Math Corps interventions and/or Fact Fluency.

**2:30 PM**

### Data entry

Record student progress and tutoring minutes from the day in Math Corps data system.



**3:10 PM**

### Teacher support

Assist with student dismissal.

**3:30 PM - 4:00 PM**

### Finish out the day

Check in with CYC coach and teachers about student progress. Prepare materials for tomorrow.
