



# Day in the life of a **READING CORPS TUTOR**

Reading Corps tutors support students in grades K–3 through weekly 20-minute tutoring sessions meeting individually or in pairs. While school schedules vary, here's what a typical day could look like!



**7:30 AM**

## **Arrive at school**

Check emails, greet students, and prepare materials for morning tutoring groups.

**8:00 AM**

## **Reading tutoring**

Meet with students individually or in small groups for 20 minute tutoring sessions.

**11:30 AM**

## **Lunch break**

Eat in staff lounge to build community or take time for self.



**12:00 PM**

## **Reading Tutoring**

Meet with students individually or in small groups for 20 minute tutoring sessions.

**3:00 PM**

## **Data entry**

Record student progress and tutoring minutes in Reading Corps data system and check email.

**3:15 PM**

## **After-school support**

Assist with after-school programming (i.e. literacy or language clubs).



**3:30 PM - 4:00 PM**

## **Finish out the day**

Review student progress, check in with CYC coach, and prepare materials for tomorrow.
